### Update procedure Audio Step 1

The Audio Software must be updated in two steps. First, please download the "**xxxx\_USB-Stick-1\_Audio.zip**" and follow the instructions. The X702D / X902D / X802D-U / INE-W710D can be updated via USB connection (see connection diagram below). Before starting to update, please check following notes. The download file is compressed in zip format. The contents of the download need to be extracted to a freshly formatted USB memory (FAT32).

3 Press "OK" button when update message appears on the screen.

- **4** When the software update is finished, the Alpine Unit will restart automatically. Keep the USB stick inserted for next update process.
- **5** Press **"OK**" button when update message appears on the screen.



\*Update will be completed in approx 1 minute.



6 Firstly remove the USB-Stick-1 then press the OK button, the reboot will take a few seconds.

Step 1 is now finished. Now go to Step 2, "xxxx\_USB-Stick-2\_Audio.zip" Update.

- 5 Turn off vehicle's ignition, remove the USB memory and turn the ignition back on to finalize the software update. Please check the firmware version number in SETUP>GENERAL>ABOUT of the Alpine unit, If "5.0000.5.0000.5.0000" is displayed the update has succeeded.
- **6** Reset the Alpine Unit by clicking Setup  $\rightarrow$  General  $\rightarrow$  About  $\rightarrow$  Reset

#### Install update software

- 1 Download the file "XXX\_USB-Stick-3\_Navigation.zip and extract it on root directory of an empty USB memory. The following folders and files have to be in the root directory of the USB stick, "LLIMOBSP", "LIMONAVI" and "LIMOAUTORUN.exe"
- 2 Safely remove the USB stick from your PC.
- 3 Push the "Map/Navigation" hard key.



Examples of navigation buttons

**4** Connect the USB memory to the USB connector of the Alpine device.

\*The update starts automatically. \*The update takes around 2 minutes.

**5** Remove the USB memory when the display indicates that the update is finished. The Alpine device restarts automatically when the USB memory is removed.



6 Check the Firmware version within the navigation menu: Information → About → Version Information. The new Firmware version is 9.18.45.743210, Sep 18 2018



7 Reset the Alpine Unit by clicking Setup  $\rightarrow$  General  $\rightarrow$  About  $\rightarrow$  Reset
